The purpose of the role will be to load and unload all steel supplies/deliveries from lorries into and out of the yard that arrive throughout the day, in a safe and organised manner whilst adhering to all health and safety guidelines. You will be expected to work on your own initiative and as part of a busy team to ensure all transportation of goods in and out is completed effectively and efficiently.

Duties Include:

- To unload steel deliveries using 4 tonne fork trucks and up to 8 tonne combi lift vehicles
- To check all steel to be loaded is signed off on the loading sheet
- To load steel bars, up to 20-meter-long, onto 40ft – 60ft trailers
- To ensure all steel has timber bearers positioned safely in between sections (training will be given)
- To load and unload the steels into and out of the paint shop when required
- To keep the yard and loading area clean and tidy to LEAN 5's quality standards
- To help in other areas when required to do so (training to be given)
